Championship Rules

- (1) In all events entry is limited to
 - (a) All players registered with Lowestoft & District TTL
 - (b) Regular attendees of the League's Coaching Scheme.
- (2) Matches will be played under the laws of the ETTA (but using 21up scoring system), the Tournament Referee appointed shall resolve the final decision in the event of any dispute.
- (3) Competitions will usually be on a simple Knockout basis except Men's and Ladies Singles or in any competition with less than 8 entries or otherwise at the discretion of the Championships Committee.
- (4) Players must report to control at the stated times on the schedule or risk exclusion at the discretion of the Tournament Referee. Reasonable time will be allowed for Sunday Worship upon request in advance to the Championships Secretary with the entry form of the player in question.
- (5) Additional Entry Qualifications (See Paragraph 1 above):

| Men's Singles and Doubles | - | Any male player |
| Women's Singles | - | Any female player |
| Mixed Doubles | - | Any male and female player (one of each per team) |
| Primary Singles and Doubles | - | Any player except those with a handicap greater than -6. (i.e. -7 to -20). |
| Veterans 50+ | - | Any player 50 years or over on or before 01/02/12 |
| Handicap Singles | - | Any player (including Juniors) |
| Youth Singles | - | Any player under 21 as at 30/06/11 |
| Junior Singles (Boys and Girls) | - | Any male or female player under 18 as at 01/01/12 |
| Cadet Singles | - | Any player under 15 as at 01/01/12 |
- (6) Where there are less than eight entrants for any event the Championships Committee reserve the right to alter the format and limit the prizes.
- (7) Men's/Ladies Singles. These competitions will be run as round robin competitions. If there are only enough entries for a single group the top two players will meet each other on finals night. The specific rules to be adopted will be advised before the start of play.
- (8) Entries for all events are accepted on the basis that players are available to play in Finals matches on Saturday 25th February 2012. Any player entered but later declaring themselves unavailable without satisfactory explanation may be subject to disciplinary action.
- (9) This schedule is a guideline drawn up prior to the entries being received. The Committee would like to run the events as explained herein but reserve the right to make any changes deemed necessary due to lack of entries or time on any particular tournament day. Players will be notified personally of such changes.
- (10) Late entries cannot be accepted.
